- ❑ Professional team

- ❑ Addressing both programme & management of National response
- ❑ Building & using tools – Strategy, Costed Action Plan, M & E – for effective management

Resource utilization – step 1

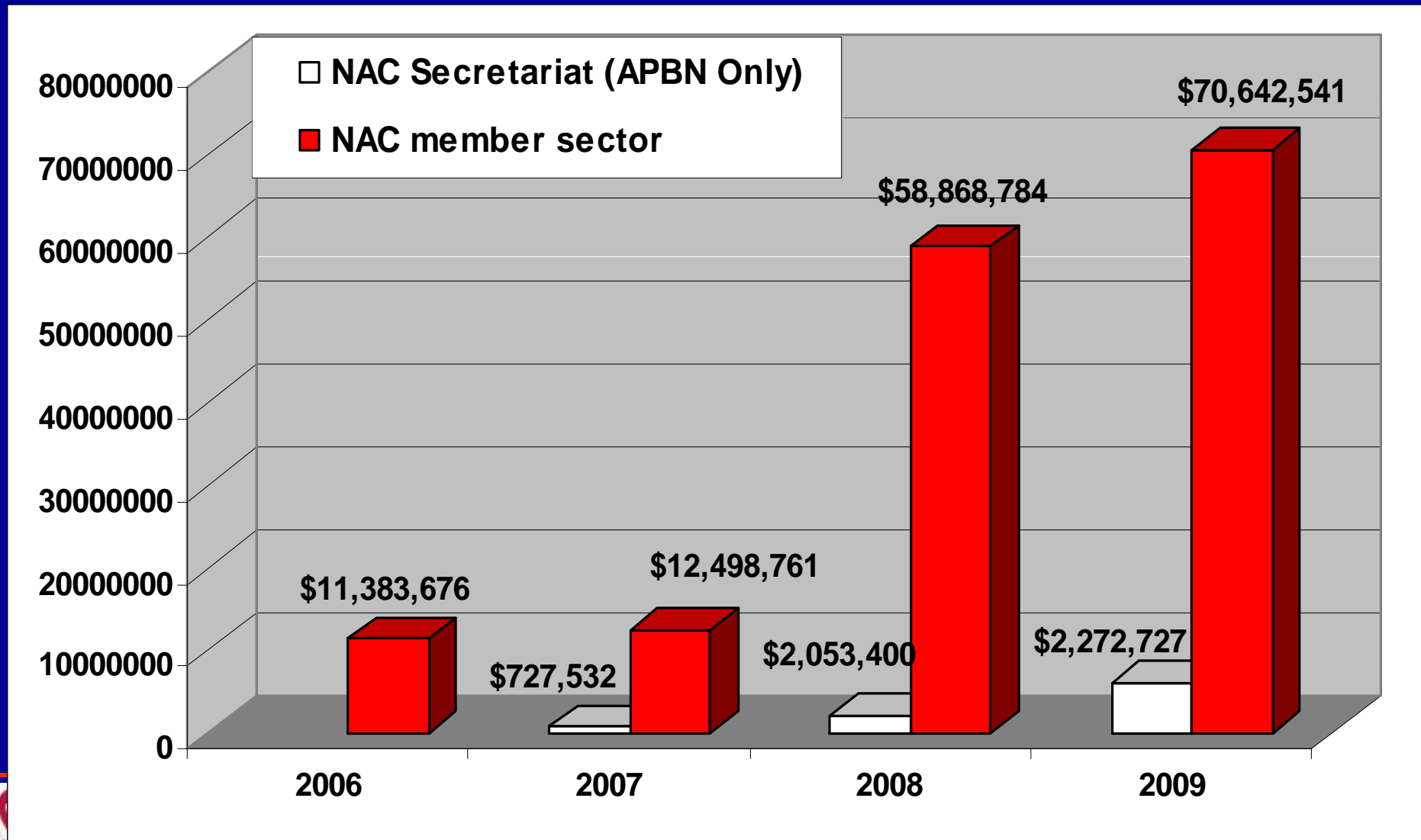
- ❑ National level : Starting with dedicated Funds (**Ind Partnership Fund**), under control of NAC Secr. Built team & tools to
→ manage pgm responsibly: transparent & accountable → gain more resources
- ❑ Prov & District level : Nat supported capacity building incl full time staff, planning, good governance and advocacy for local funds



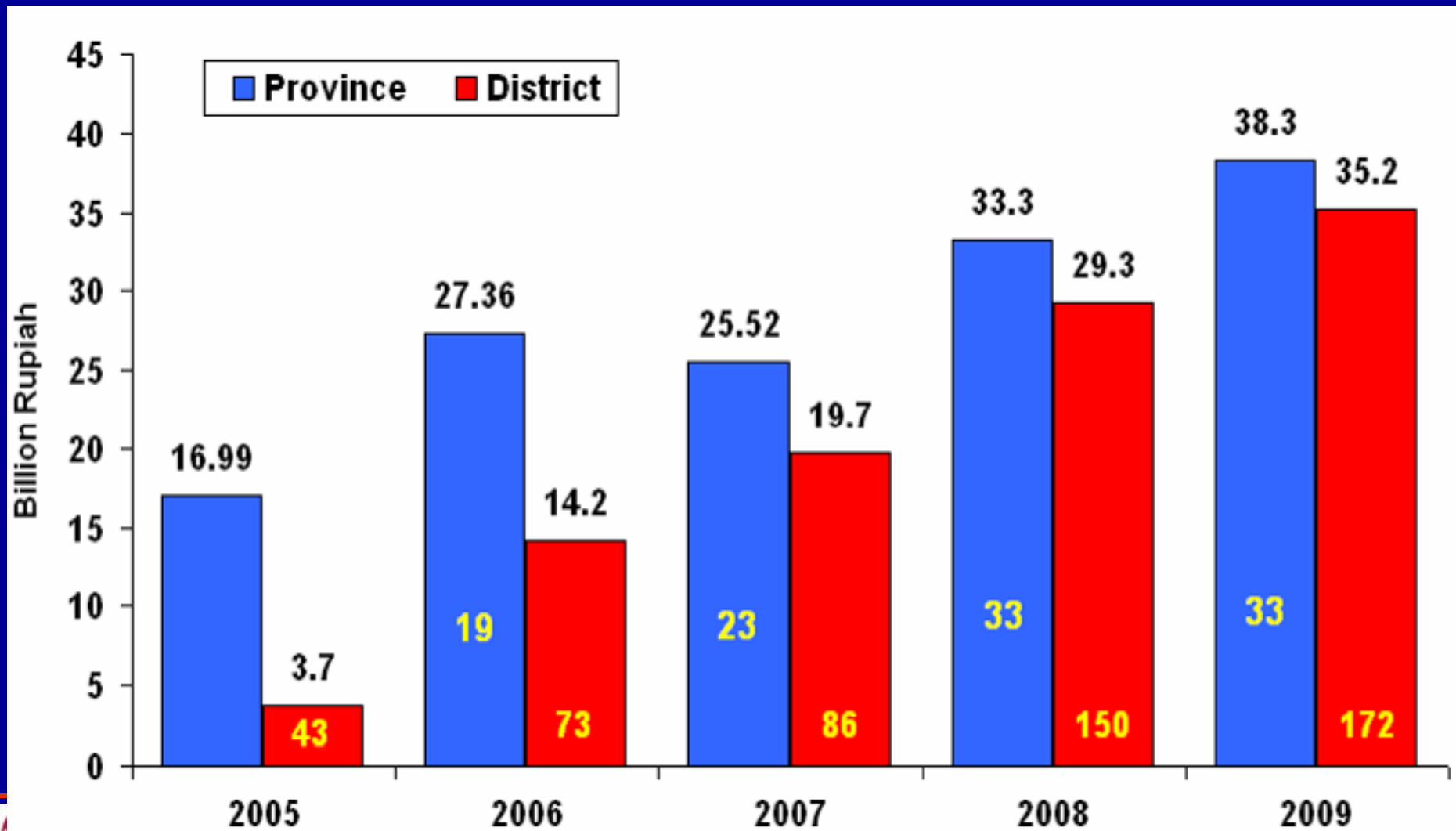
Resource utilization & mobilization – step 2

- ❑ More collaboration & more equal partnership with donor community
- ❑ Work with National Planning Board and Min of Fin. → more domestic resources
- ❑ Continuing advocacy w local (Prov, District & Municipal) government
- ❑ Applied for & received Global Fund

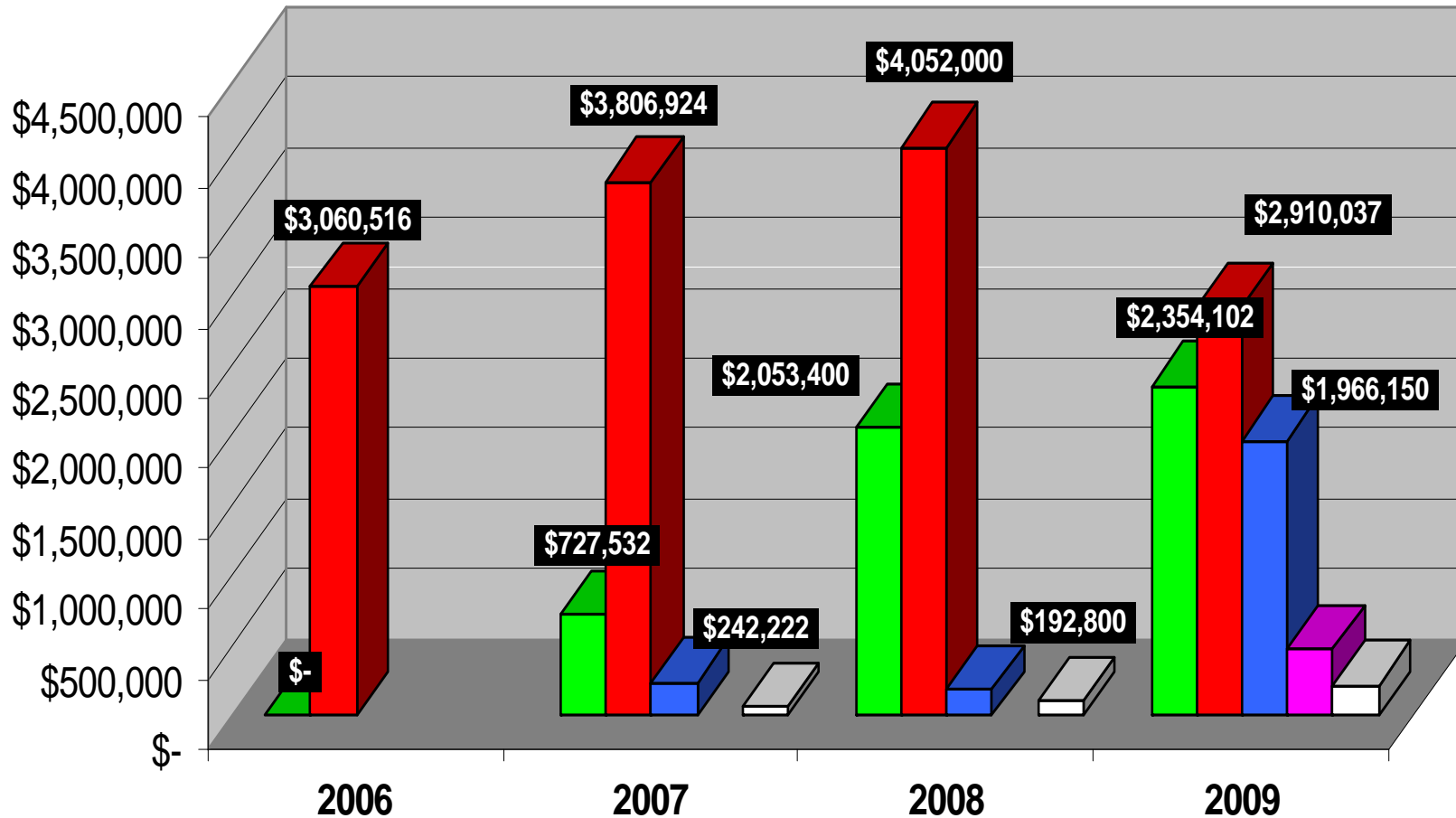
Growing APBN Allocation for the National Response 2006 - 2009, in US\$

The changing landscape of funds managed by NAC secretariate

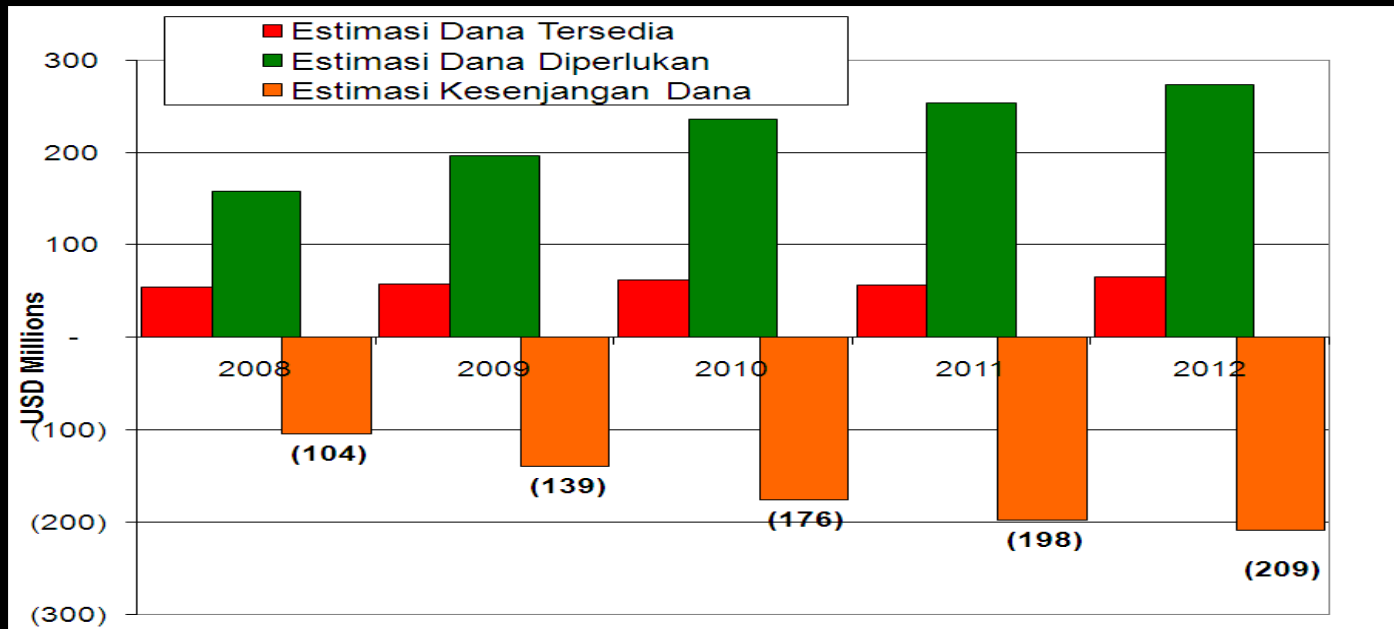

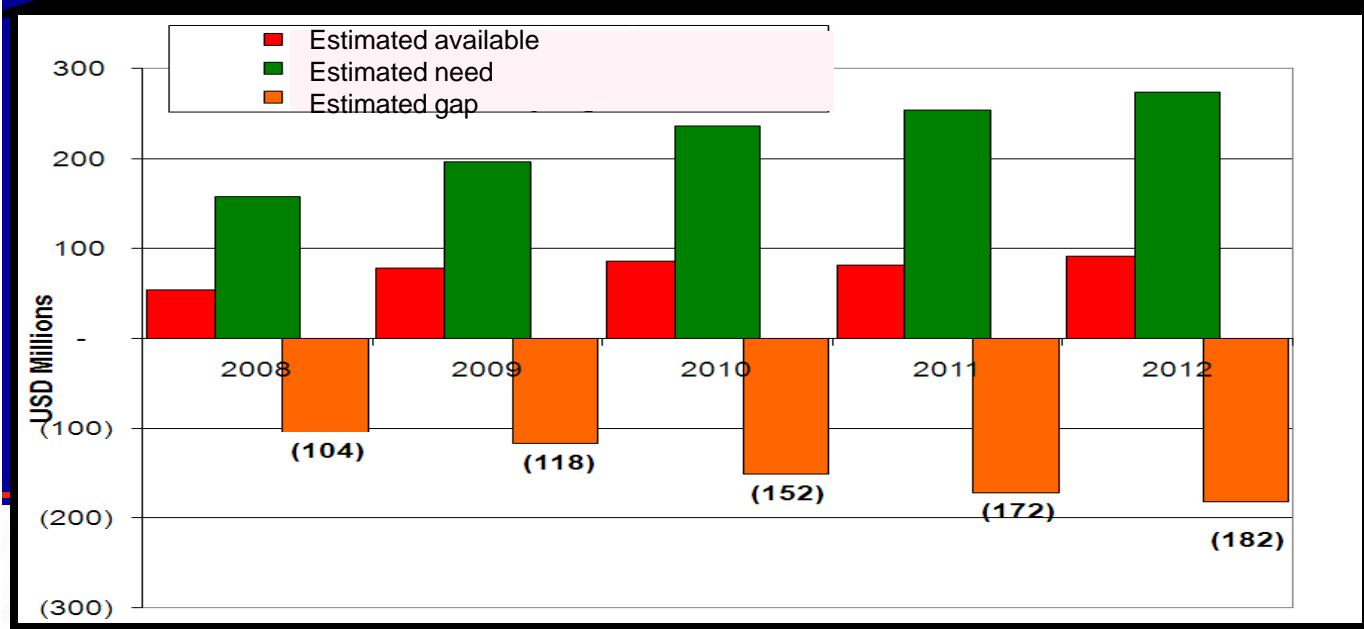

Evolution of AIDS Governance

Building inclusive systems

- 1) Presidential Regulation No 75/ 2006 provided NAC with mandate to lead the National AIDS response**
- 2) Govt & CSO including PLHIV, Academics, NGO → equal membership >> working partnership**
- 3) Governance of Indonesian Partnership Fund consultative → vehicle to promote dialogue and common understanding among NAC secr & partners in discussion of pgm**

Evolution of Governance at sub-national levels : all 33 Prov

Development of AIDS Commission “system”:

- ❑ Advocacy with sub-national top level officials: executive & legislative**
- ❑ Operational & technical support of secretariat of AIDS Commissions all levels – planning, M & E, finance, advocacy**
- ❑ Field visits & multi-province regional meetings**
- ❑ Building organization culture of good governance and caring**
